

Direct vs. Indirect Costs



The Estimated Cost of Attendance includes the average costs for a student to attend UC Davis for one academic year. It is the sum of all budget components including both direct and indirect costs.

Direct costs: Charges included in the cost of attendance that are charged to MyBill. Actual charges may vary by student.

Indirect costs: Estimated expenses in the cost of attendance that are not charged to MyBill and the student may have control over the amounts.
